# REMINDER: KC MARK WILL BE FULLY IMPLEMENTED BY JANUARY 1<sup>ST</sup> 2011

Further to our SafeGuardS (<u>051/10 dated March 2010</u>), please note the date for compliance with the new certification symbol; the KC Mark, is imminent. This affects a wide range of products and services destined for Korea; See Table 1.



#### SUMMARY

To protect public health and safety, companies are required to obtain prior certification from authorized bodies before they can put certain products on the market. Items subject to legally compulsory certification are specified in related laws and ordinances pertaining to safety, health, environment and quality. KATS (Korean Agency for

Technology and Standards) revised the Framework Act on National Standards and its Enforcement Decree and introduced its national integrated certification mark on July 1, 2009. The single Korea Certification mark ("KC mark" in its abbreviation) integrated and unified all 13 existing legally compulsory certification marks.

#### MORE DETAILS

The Ministry of Knowledge Economy introduced the unified KC mark system on July 1, 2009. The system will be fully implemented by January 1, 2011 for the following 13 compulsory certification, with the participation of other responsible ministries.



#### c. KC - Safety Quality Labeling (for textile and leather products)

CLASS	ITEM
TEXTILE PRODUCTS <sup>1</sup>	Textile products for children between 3 and 12 years old (Inner, mid, outer wear, ties, socks, shoes, etc.)
	2. Inner wear - contacting with skin (chemise, drawers, brazier ,panties, slip, garter belt, corset/cirdle, panier, brief, undershirt, pregnancy underwear, sleepwear, etc.)
	3. Mid wear - contacting with skin (Blouse, Pants, Shirts, Towel, Gloves, Socks/Tights, Stocking, Wig, etc.)
	4. Outer wear - contacting with skin (Suit, Sweater, Jacket, Coat, Jumper, Hat, Shawl, Muffler, Vest, Scarf, Shoes, etc.)
	5. Bedding - products used for sleeping (Quilt, Blanket, Sleeping bag, Cover, Carpet, etc.)
	6. Others - safety requirement is not applied to product not wearing directly (Bag, Cushion, Mosquito net, Cover, Winding sheet, etc / No tests required)
LEATHER PRODUCTS	Leather and fur material only
	2. Shoes - Upper leather, lining, insole only
