BELGIAN SENATE APPROVES BAN ON BPA IN CERTAIN FOOD CONTACT PRODUCTS

In January 2012, the Senate of Belgium approved a proposal to prohibit the use of bisphenol A (BPA) in the manufacture of food contact materials and articles for children under the age of three¹. In order for the proposal to become law, the text must be approved by the House of Representatives. The proposed effective date is 1 January 2013. Highlights of the proposal are summarised in the table below:

In the European Union, the migration of BPA is regulated in plastic food contact materials and articles under Regulation (EU) 10/2011 and prohibited specifically in polycarbonate infant feeding bottles under Regulation (EU) 321/2011². BPA content is regulated in additional products exceeding EU requirements in <u>Austria</u> (pacifiers and teethers), <u>Denmark</u> (food contact materials and articles for children up to the age of three) and <u>France</u> (baby bottles).
