FRANCE SPECIFIES METHODS AND LIMITS FOR FORMAMIDE IN PUZZLE MATS

France accepts one of three testing methods for demonstration of compliance with formamide in puzzle mats. This new law is effective until 20 July, 2012.

In December 2010, France and Belgium became the first 2 member states in the European Union (EU) to announce the removal of puzzle mats containing excessive levels of formamide¹. At that time, France prohibited the marketing of puzzle mats for three months followed by an extension of the prohibition until 15 July 2011².

On 22 July 2011, France published its requirements for formamide in puzzle mats in the Official Journal of the French Republic³. The new law allows three possible methods and their corresponding limits for demonstration of compliance. One of the methods analyses formamide content and the other two methods determine the emission of formamide using chamber methods.

Until 20 July 2012, a manufacturer, importer or distributor cannot place puzzle mats on the market unless demonstration of compliance is achieved using one of these three methods. Highlights of the new law are summarised in Table 1.
